# A LETTER FROM OUR *executive director*

Dear Champions,

In 2024, our teen moms demonstrated remarkable perseverance despite the challenges they faced. They are truly our heroes! While caring for their little ones, these dedicated teen moms are not only completing their high school education, obtaining their GEDs or going to college but also are working to support their families. Many of them are navigating difficult living situations, including abuse and addiction. Day in and day out, they dig deep to find the courage to keep moving forward.

Hope House Northern Colorado experienced significant growth this past year, **serving 30 teen moms and 39 children** - our largest numbers to date. This surge reflects the growing need for economic assistance and the desire among our moms to improve their lives. I am incredibly proud of their commitment to education and career readiness, which resulted in a **73% improvement** in economic self-sufficiency among our participants.

This year, we adopted a new, research-based revision of our self-sufficiency rubric, which measures three personal domains and four economic domains. This tool tracks our teen moms' progress and allows us to celebrate their achievements. For many, it's the first time someone has encouraged them to pursue their dreams.

Our dedicated team at Hope House continues to provide exceptional support to our teen moms. In response to the increasing demand, we welcomed an additional program coordinator this year. We are also grateful for our incredible volunteers—**49 individuals who contributed 167 hours of service**, bringing love and support to our teen moms and their children.

Thanks to your support, our teen moms are breaking the cycle of generational poverty and rewriting their stories. Your contributions are transforming the lives of two generations—teen moms and their children.

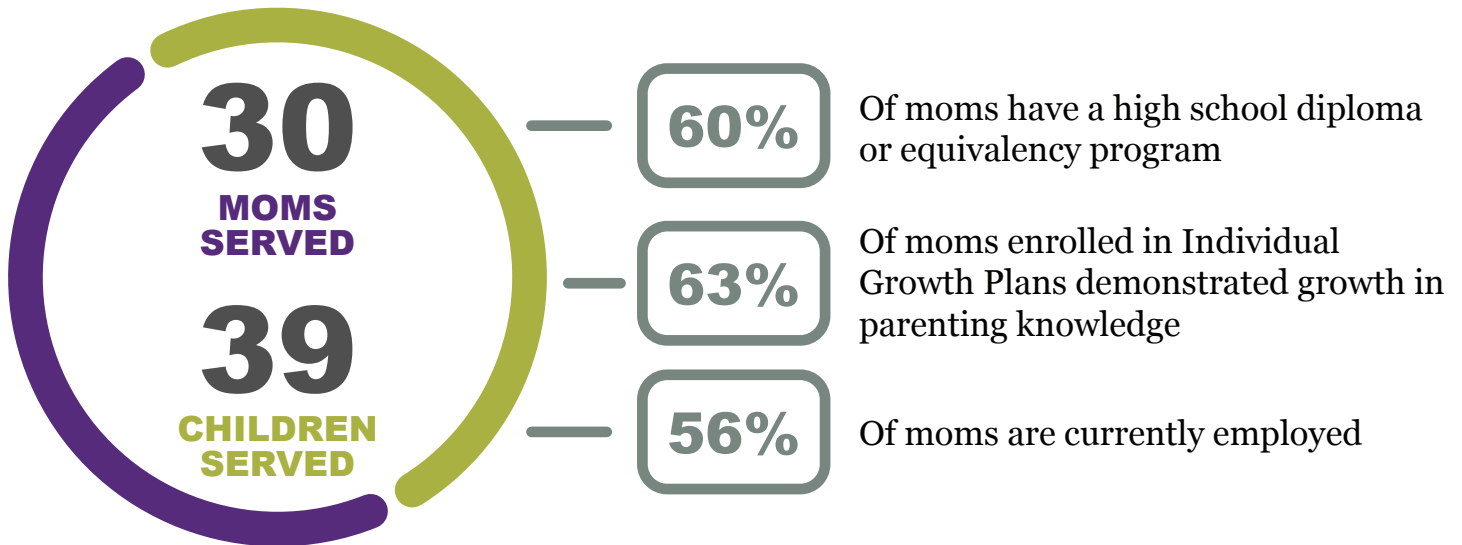

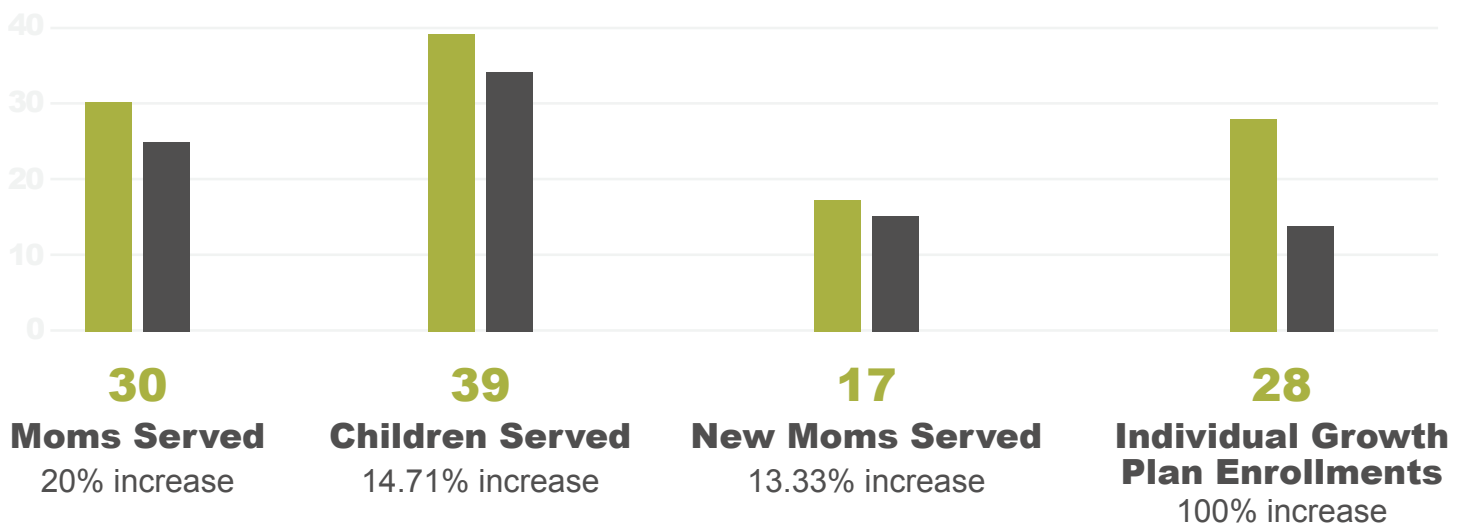
